## **2024 IMPACT REPORT** THE RACE TO BELONG









We are so grateful to continue our work to improve the experiences and outcomes for kids in foster care in Tennessee. Thanks to your support, we reached significant milestones and are holding onto hope for what this will mean for our state's most vulnerable youth.

Early in 2024, we laced up our running shoes to prepare for the Dairy Dash. As beneficiaries of this longstanding Nashville event, we were able to raise awareness and more than \$205,000 in critical funds in a new, moo-ving way.

Next, we shifted gears and sped to Bristol Motor Speedway to capture stories of kids in care seeking adoption through our I Belong Project<sup>™</sup>. There, we filmed our 1,000th video in the hopes of accelerating connections between incredible kids and loving, adoptive families.

We also diligently prepared for the launch of Every Child TN. This partnership with the Governor's Office, provides a statewide roadmap to recruit and retain more foster families. We revved our engines in support and made intentional hires to better serve families in all corners of our state.

With all that was new, we also turbocharged our commitment to core programming by hosting Next Steps recruitment events and continuing to bring on more Foster Friendly partners to WRAP around deserving foster, kinship and adoptive parents. Thank you for running the race with us.

- Filmed our 1,000th I Belong Project<sup>™</sup> video while racing around Bristol, Møtør/Speedway
- Filmed 199 kids at 11 high-quality shoots, an increase of 260% from 2016/1BP launch
- Received 1,133 inquiries on children featured through the I Belong Project
- Of 1,148 kids filmed since 2016, 50% have found forever families
