Our I Belong Project™ is a flagship program that creates videos of kids in care, eligible for adoption, to help them find adoptive homes. Last year we produced 468 videos and 423 children got matched.

We enlist businesses, faith communities and civic organizations to become Foster Friendly and connect them with local foster families through our innovative Foster Friendly App. We added 761 new Foster Friendly businesses and faith communities.
